## **Thesis Sentences and Topic Sentences**

Thesis: a sentence about the essay subject with insightful commentary about it. The thesis is the umbrella statement for the entire essay – all other ideas must "hang" from it. It belongs in the Introduction Paragraph, usually at the end.

Topic Sentence: The topic sentence is the first sentence of a body paragraph. It contains more specific information about the essay subject and commentary about it.

Example: Wearing school uniforms is unfair to students because it limits their personal freedom.
